### HILLSIDE RALLIES TO STOP WILSON, 13-6

It was the second victory for the Hornets but not without plenty of trouble. Hillside was balted twice after traveling deep into Darden territory.

Later in the same period Dickerson, Hornet fullback, going off tackle, broke the scoring ice with a brilliant 55 yard touchdown jaunt. The conversion was good.

From then on neither team was able to score again. However, both threatened. The game ended, 13-6.
