Education Essential

Stoshuk, along with health department and school officials, feels education—especially among teenagers — is essential in keeping VD under control.

People in Raleigh and outlying towns of Wake don't believe there is a VD problem here. Stoshak said. "But we find cases in every town all the time. And you can't expect these people to wear a sign." he added.

The VD education program should not be a sermon on morality, he said. "But we've got to do more to teach people about the diseases, their danger, and how to detect them." Stoshak added.


