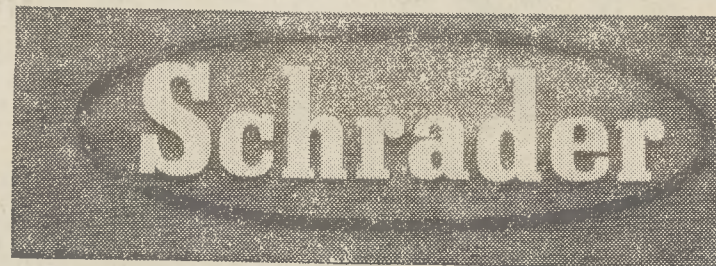
Daniel Reunion
