THE SEXUAL SAFETY CARD.

SAFEST: Mutual masturbation • Dry kissing • Body rubbing •
Unshared sex toys • Oral sex with a condom •
Fantasy, voyeurism, exhibitionism

PROBABLY SAFE, POSSIBLY UNSAFE: Deep kissing • Using a condom during intercourse •
External watersports • Oral sex, withdrawing
before climax

UNSAFE: Intercourse without a condom • Fisting • Rimming •
Shared sex toys • Watersports, swallowed

The safest activities involve only skin-to-skin contact. Any activity that involves the
exchange of semen, blood, or vaginal fluid may be dangerous.
