Proclamation from the Mayor

WHEN DISCRIMINATION EXISTS, THERE ARE NO INNOCENT BYSTANDERS.

THOSE WHO STAND BY WHILE OTHERS ARE MADE TARGETS OF DISCRIMINATION AND BIGOTRY MUST SHARE THE GUILT. HAVING FOUGHT LONG AND
HARD AGAINST DISCRIMINATION OF ANY KIND AND BELIEVING THAT
OPPRESSION AND PERSECUTION OF ANYONE JEOPARDIZES EVERYONE, I AM
ONCE AGAIN MOVED TO SPEAK OUT FOR EQUALITY, JUSTICE, TOLERANCE
AND PEACE ON BEHALF OF MY FRIENDS IN THE GAY AND LESBIAN COMMUNITY. THE VALUE AND WORTH OF EVERY INDIVIDUAL MUST NOT BE TAMPERED WITH OR DIMINISHED BY A DOCTRINE BASED ON JUDGEMENT AND
CONDEMNATION. AS MOTHER TERESA SAID, "WHEN YOU JUDGE PEOPLE,
