Prices Fluctuate Within Range of Five Points—Close Is Steady at Net Advance of 3 to 5 Points.

New York, April 15.—The cotton market was quiet today and prices fluctuated within a range of five points. July ruled between 11.99 and 12.02, closing at 12.00, with the general bid closing steady at a net advance of 3 to 5 points.
