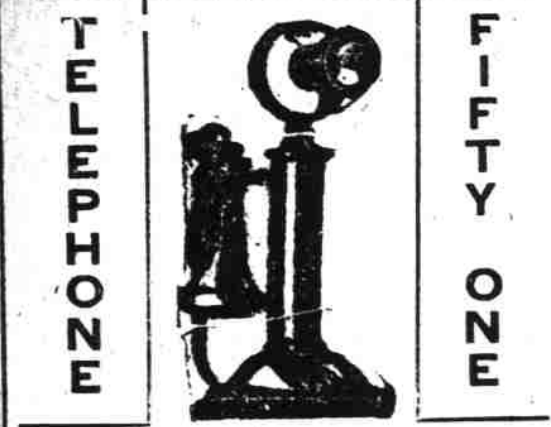

TO PROBE AUSTRIA'S MILITARY COLLAPSE People Indignant Over Manner in Which War Was Conducted—Intense Hatred For Officers. Vienna, Thursday, Dec. 19.—(Reuters.)—Popular indignation over the general conduct of the war, "especially the brutality, arrogance and incompetence" displayed by the highest Austrian military commanders, found expression in a resolution adopted by the German Austrian national assembly today determining the appointment of a commission to investigate the cause of Austria-Hungary's military collapse.

In the course of a vigorous debate on the grave charges advanced against high officers, it was declared that members of the imperial family, regardless of age or military capacity, had been given commands with the most disastrous results. A field marshal who commanded an expedition against Serbia was denounced as responsible for the death of thousands whom he drove to slaughter, insufficiently munitioned, fed and clothed, some of the deputies declared that he ought to be hanged.

Intense hatred against the entire body of officers is prevailing among civilians. These officers are accused publicly of wholesale thefts during the war, of living luxuriously and permitting their wives to wear costly jewelry, while the masses starved.

The Vienna newspapers urged the investigating committee to begin work before the commanders implicated are able to destroy the documentary proof of their guilt.

Norfolk, Va., Dec. 21.—The coast guard cutter Seminole which has been standing by the stranded Greek steamer Elin, off Currituck inlet, was relieved today by the wrecking tug Resolute, and is proceeding to port. All efforts to float the Elin so far have failed.
