STATE ELECTORS CAST 12 BALLOTS FOR COX

He and Roosevelt Nominated in Eloquent Speeches at a Formal Meeting

 RALEIGH, Jan. 12.—Special supporters of President-elect Warren G. Harding in the recent election would have been moved if not swayed by the eloquence which attended the formal gathering of the presidential electors held here this morning had they heard it before November.

Col. Albert L. Cox, of Raleigh, was selected to go to Washington February 9 and cast the state's five votes for Democracy, the same representing the biggest majority recorded below the Mason and Dixon line. Colonel Cox nominated Governor Cox for President and former Speaker Brummitt nominated Franklin D. Roosevelt for vice president, and the electors voted solidly for the victims of the landslide.

Former Senator Lindsay Warren was selected as elector in place of Stewart of Washington, and Dr. J. Y. Joyner was chosen to fill the vacancy in the electoral college caused by the death of J. L. Barham, of Goldsboro, Charles A. Hines, of Greensboro, served in place of Ben Holden, of Louisburg, who could not be present.

When the electors gathered they selected Felix A. S. Selig, of Wake County, as chairman, and Col. R. B. Redwine, of Monroe, as secretary.

The Democratic candidates were placed in nomination in just as serious vein as though the event were in the San Francisco convention hall instead of the senate chamber in Raleigh and 12 votes were formally recorded for Cox and Roosevelt.

Colonel Cox and W. A. Seif, of Hickory, were the electors-at-large, while each congressional district had an elector. Colonel Cox was selected by the 12 to take the news to Washington.
