

TO LAUNCH CONCRETE RIVER VESSEL AT NEW BERN MONDAY

Many to Attend Ceremony At Newport Shipyard, New Bern

The Newport Shipbuilding company, operating yards in Wilmington and New Bern, will next Monday afternoon launch a 150-foot concrete river vessel at the New Bern yards and officials of the company, in addition to a number of citizens are arranging to be present for the ceremonies. Full details for the launching have not yet been arranged, President Kirby Smith stated yesterday, as his arrival at New Bern Monday morning will result in a conference of interested persons who will plan the ceremonies. The new ship is said to be a beauty in every respect and considerable interest attaches to the ceremony to be staged. Rapid progress is being made by the company of ships now being poured in the Wilmington yards, though launchings are considerably removed as yet.
