CAN'T JOIN LEAGUE AS TREATY SEEMS TO SAY

Secretary Hughes Did Not Intend to Leave Door Open for This Country

By DAVID LAWRENCE (Copyright, 1921, by The Star) WASHINGTON, Aug. 31.—Secretary Hughes is of the opinion that the new treaty with Germany doesn't permit the United States to join the league of nations except by a treaty to which the senate has given its constitutional consent. He didn't intend the language of the new pact to be interpreted in any other way and had no desire to use phrases which could in any way give rise to the consideration of an absurd viewpoint—namely the joining of the league without the consent of the senate.
