# DRASTIC CLOTURE FOR S. V. TEW

Will Meet You at Elvington's Majority Members Favor Putting An End to Unlimited Windjamming

> WASHINGTON, Sept. 29 .- (By Associated Press.) - A movement to curtail senatorial privilege of practically unlimited debate reached such proportions today that an unofficial committee of Republican senators went to the white house and conferred on the question with President Harding.

While the proposed rule has not yet been drawn up, it was indicated that the plan contemplates a change in the senate rules so that cloture would be invoked by a mere majority vote, instead of by two-thirds vote now required. After invocation of the rule, each senator's time for debate would be limited to one hour, it was said. Sudden as was the movement to definitely restrict the ancient rule permitting senators to speak at length, those behind the plan declared tonight that for the first time in the senate's history adoption of a real majority cloture rule impended.

The informal committee that discussed the matter with the president, consisted of Senators Lenroot of Wiscon-Freylinhausen of New Jersey, and Kellogg of Minnesota, and were said to have received assurance that the executive would not interpose any objections to the cloture plan.

The movement so far has been conined to a number of Republican senators, having been initiated actively at conference of about a dozen Repubicans last night. The "charter members" comprise mostly Republicans of the younger group, including, however, senators from both eastern and west-

Obstruction of the anti-beer bill recently in the sanete was said to have been the immediate cause of the new cloture movement. It was said in addition, however, that during the recent recess of congress, senators had heard many complaints of delay in senate business because of filibustering and other methods of protracting debate. Many Republican senators were sounded out today and a majority were said to have expressed themselves favorably to the new plan. Among those who today were enrolled among the supporters of the plan were a number of prominent senators, influential in
