WASHINGTON, Jan. 23 .- Presiden Harding, declared by his personal physician, Brig-Gen. C. E. Sawyer, virtually to have recovered from the attack of grippe which he contracted more than a week ago, remained in seclusion today at the white house to rest. The usual Tuesday cabinet meeting was cancelled as scheduled meeting with newspaper correspondents. No official papers were sent to the white house for presidential action, and no visitors were permitted to see Mr. Harding. It had been indicated yesterday that the President would be back at his desk today. Dr. Sawyer said, however, that he could not tell at this time when the President would be permitted to re-turn to the executive offices.
