

ARRANGE TENTATIVE CONVENTION PROGRAM

Local Club Making Big Plans to Entertain Members of State Woman's Organization

Plans for the entertainment of the 150 delegates expected to attend the annual convention of the North Carolina State Federation of Business and Professional Women's clubs were discussed at a special called meeting of the local Business and Professional Women's club, held last night in the custom house building.

The convention dates are June 15 and 16, and all business sessions are to be held at the Oceanic hotel, on Wrightsville beach. In addition to the large number of delegates expected to be here to represent the various clubs throughout the state, several officials of the national organization are expected to be present and to make addresses.

Members of the local club are planning to entertain their guests royally. Several social functions will be held. An informal reception is to be given at the Oceanic hotel on the first day of the convention, which is Thursday, and on Friday a luncheon will be held at the Cape Fear Country club. Saturday the delegates will be taken to Fort Fisher in automobiles and on Saturday evening a special dance will be held for them at Lumina.

Soviets Torturing Imprisoned Prelate

MOSCOW, April 23.—(By Associated Press)—Reports arriving here from Moscow are to the effect that the Soviet political department is subjecting the Most Rev. Tikhon to electrical shocks, hoping to extort from him a declaration that he recognizes the Soviet government as Russia's legal government, and also communist doctrines as compatible with the highest religious principles.

It is asserted that the strict prison regime has seriously affected the prelate's health, and that the bolsheviks are attempting to shatter his nerves by giving him graphic accounts of the execution of Monsignor Butchkavich and also by telling him of the demands made by Bishop Ananin of the "Living Church," and Bishop Vedensky, head of the Unified Apostolic church for his punishment.

Death of Convict Blamed on Guard

LANSING, Mich., April 23.—Frank Patterson, Ionia reformatory inmate, probably died as a result of a blow on the head inflicted by a prison guard, according to Warden Charles Shean.

The warden said today that he knew Patterson had been struck on the head by a guard named Leo Rolfe. The blow was delivered in self-defense, he said, and he considered the guard's action justified. Patterson, the warden asserted, turned on Rolfe when he was ordered to his quarters, and with two other inmates attempted a jail delivery. Rolfe struck him on the head with a

club, with which prison guards are armed.

At the time of Patterson's death, Warden Shean was in Lansing and reported that Patterson had probably died from injuries sustained when he fell against a locker during the melee. Since then, he said, a coroner's inquest has revealed that he was struck on the head by the guard, and other information has been obtained to show that the guard struck Patterson to ward off attack.
