ORDER AUTHORIZING \$12,000 COUNTY HOME BONDS

BE IT ORDERED AND RE- solved by the Board of Commissioners for the County of New Hanover:

1. That bonds of New Hanover County be issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, in an amount not exceeding \$12,000 for the purpose of constructing additions to the County Home for the indigent and infirm of said County, the same being a necessary expense of the County.

2. That a tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds when due shall be annually levied and collected.

3. That a statement of the County debt has been filed with the Clerk and is open to public inspection.

4. That this order shall take effect thirty days after the first publication thereof after final passage, unless in the meantime a petition for its submission to the voters is filed under said Act and that in such event it shall take effect when approved by the voters of the County at an election as provided in said Act.

The foregoing order was finally passed on the 26th day of February, 1940, and was first published on the 27th day of February, 1940. Any action or proceeding questioning the validity of said order must be commenced within 30 days after its first publication.

ORDER AUTHORIZING \$86,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS

WHEREAS, the County Board of Education of New Hanover County has certified to this Board a resolution passed by said County Board of Education on February 12, 1940, showing that it is necessary in order to maintain the constitutional six months' school term in New Hanover County to provide certain school improvements described in said resolution; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Education has requested this Board to order the issuance of County bonds in order to secure the necessary funds for providing said school improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Com- missioners has carefully examined the facts and has determined and hereby finds as a fact that the statements of said resolution are true and that it has become the duty of said Board of Commissioners, acting as an administrative agent of the State in providing a state system of public schools, to order the issuance of a sufficient amount of County bonds to provide all of said school improvements in order to maintain the constitutional six months' school term; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDERED AND RE- solved by the Board of Commissioners for the County of New Hanover:

1. That bonds of New Hanover County be issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, in an amount not exceeding \$86,000 for the purpose of providing funds for constructing the school improvements referred to in the first preamble of this bond order in order to maintain the constitutional six months' school term, such improvements consisting of the following:

Constructing additions to the Wrightsboro school, located in Cape Fear township, New Hanover County, North Carolina.

Constructing additions to and remodeling the Hemenway school, located in Wilmington, North Carolina.

Constructing additions to and remodeling the Cornelius Harnett school, located in Wilmington, North Carolina.

Constructing additions to and remodeling the New Hanover High school, located in Wilmington, North Carolina.

Constructing additions to and remodeling the Winter Park school, located in Harnett township, New Hanover County, North Carolina. Remodeling various schools for
