NAZI SUPPLY SHIP BOMBED BY R. A. F.

Air Ministry Reports Craft Hit By High Explosive Bomb Off Dutch Coast

LONDON, July 5.—An air ministry bulletin tonight said a large German supply ship, one of a group of four sighted off the Dutch coast, was hit by a high explosive bomb yesterday.

The bulletin said: "A large German supply ship, one of a group of four seen some miles off the Dutch coast, was hit by a high explosive bomb during a series of daylight raids carried out by R. A. F. bombers soon after noon yesterday.

"As the raiders approached they found the German ships stationary and facing in different directions while their escort of two destroyers was steaming towards them.

"The enemy was taken so completely by surprise at the dive attack of the British aircraft that not a single anti-aircraft gun was fired."

Another air ministry bulletin said a small German guard ship mounting anti-aircraft guns was "completely overturned" by a bomb dropped from an American Lockheed Hudson aircraft of the coastal command early this morning.

Other patrol vessels were left in a "sinking condition" the bulletin declared.

A supply ship was attacked and damaged near Stavenger, the bulletin added.

1 cup granulated sugar
 3-4 cup shortening
 1 egg well beaten
 2 cups Dainty Flour
 1-2 teaspoons baking powder
 1 teaspoon vanilla
 1-2 cup nut meats.

Cream shortening and sugar, add beaten egg and mix well. Sift flour, measure, and sift again together with baking powder, and add to first mixture. Add vanilla and nut meats. Mold into rolls and wrap in waxed paper. Place in refrigerator over night. Cut in thin slices and bake at 425 degrees F. about 8 minutes. Makes 3 dozen cookies.
