#### Sept. 5, 6 Announced by Superintendent; Holiday List Compiled

Sept. 5 and 6 have been set as dates for the registration of new students in county schools for the beginning of the new school year. Supt. H. M. Roland announced vesterday.

An increase of at least 1,000 students to the regular enrollment of 11,000 is anticipated when the new school year gets underway fficially wth start of classes Sept. the official reported.

Students who wish to avoid delay and complete as soon as possible details in connection with the transfer of credits to either the white or colored high schools may do so at any time since those in stitutions are open all summer, Supt. Roland pointed out.




Lee, Moore, Hartnett Counties Added to Local Area Office of Loan Agency


