

## Shipping Of Gas Via Canal Tried

FORT MYERS, Fla., May 25-(P)-To try out the Caloosahatchee cross-state waterway for hauling gasoline, the Southeastern Oil Company today started loading 70 .-000 gallons into the steel barges to be towed by a tug from Fort Myers to Jacksonville.

The trip will be the first trial run of a project to haul gasoline from the oil fields of the upper Gulf coast to the Eastern Seaboard via the waterway and inshore route to evade U-boats.

Capt. Arthur Oliver of Palatka is skipper of the tug which will make the trial run. Gasoline is being brought here from Tampa and loaded aboard the barges. Capt. Oliver said several days would be required to finish loading.
