180 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING \$600,000.00 WATER WORKS EXTENSION BONDS BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wilmington: Section 1. That the City of Wilmington issue its bonds, pursuant

to The Municipal Finance Act, 1921, as amended, in an amount not exceeding \$600,000.00 for the purpose of paying all or a part of the cost of constructing extensions to the existing water works system of said City, including the acquisition of a new source of supply.

Section 2. That a tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds shall be annually levied and collected

Section 3. That a statement of the debt of the City has been filed with the Clerk and is open to public inspection. Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect when approved by the voters of the City at an election as provided by law.
