### Italy Executes Youth For Food Law Violation

BERN, Switzerland, June 14.—(AP)—Fascist newspapers received here today gave headline prominence to Italy's first execution for violation of the country's food laws.

While the case of a 23-year-old youth who was put to death by shooting in the back was complicated by the murder of the policeman who attempted to arrest him, Premier Mussolini's Il Popolo D'Italia declared that the execution demonstrated the resolution of the authorities to break every attempt to tamper with the food restrictions.

The youth was charged with the illegal sale of flour.
