Portugese Premier Predicts Europe In Ruins At War's End

LISBON, Portugal, June 25.—(AP)—Dr. Antonio de Oliveira Salazar, anti-democratic premier of Portugal, in discussing post-war economic problems tonight mentioned "an eventual English victory."

Many persons, he said, undoubtedly planned to "turn an eventual English victory into an 'ideological victory' in order to replace in former positions those principally responsible for the disorder and misery of the last 20 years."

Dr. Salazar, who has ruled Portugal since 1928 and has created a system of government which often has been officially described as "neither Fascism nor Nazism and much less Communism," expressed trust in "four or six" men who are ruling the world to face the problems of Europe, which he said "will be nothing but ruins and material and moral desolation" at the end of the war.

G-MAN ATTACKER KILLED BY POLICE

22 Year Old Man Sought By F. B. I. After He Disarms Agent

GRAND RAPIDS, Mich., June 25.—(AP)—James McCarter Leonard, 22 year-old Cheboygan, Mich., youth who had been the object of a statewide search since escaping from Detroit F.B.I. officers in Detroit Wednesday night, was shot and killed here today in the Loraine hotel by city detectives.

Leonard, still wearing the blue sailor suit in which he was being questioned yesterday when he disarmed Detroit F.B.I. agents, and fled, exchanged a fusillade of shots with detectives Frank Breen and Glen Lane before he was mortally wounded. Neither of the detectives was injured.

The youth had taken a room at the hotel today, and police were called when hotel officials became suspicious.

The two detectives, obtaining a pass-key to the room, were met at the door by Leonard, who covered Lane with two pistols, ordering him into the room. Leonard closed the door, then forced the detective to call Breen, who had remained outside.

Breen, suspecting a trick, opened the door and began shooting, hitting Leonard in the chest with his first shot. The youth fell beneath a table, from where he fired nine shots at Breen, all wild before he collapsed.

F.B.I. agents took the youth into custody in Detroit late Wednesday afternoon for questioning on a charge of illegally wearing the blue uniform of the U. S. Navy.

While being questioned by an agent on the ninth floor of the Federal building, Leonard suddenly whipped out a revolver, fired three shots—one grazing his chest, one striking the agent's elbow—disarmed the agent and forced a charwoman to take him down the elevator to the street level.

He walked past guards and out onto the street where he commandeered the automobile of a passing motorist, changed to another by drawing the gun on its driver, and outraced police in a mad dash across the city punctuated by two crashes with other automobiles and one with a street car.

Late last night the car he was driving collided with another in Northville and when police appeared in a scout car to investigate, he held up the officers and fled in the scout car.

Today the cruiser was found abandoned near Howell, Mich., 40 miles from Detroit, and the chase had centered there until the youth was cornered here.

Naval Experts Believe Enemy Subs Are Based Near American Shores

WASHINGTON, June 25.—(AP)—Senator Byrd (D-Va) informed the senate today that naval experts believed enemy submarines were based somewhere in striking distance of the Atlantic coast.

"It is imperative that such bases be broken up," Byrd said. "Every indication is that these bases are in and around the Caribbean sea."

America should take over Martinique "if it is necessary for our protection," the senator added.

Errol Flynn's Standin Arrested After Fight

HOLLYWOOD, June 25.—(AP)—A backyard clash between Errol Flynn's stand-in and Barbara Huton's butler—aftermath of a birthday party for the actor attended by numerous movie notables—led to the arrest of the stand-in today as the butler lay near death.

So widely divergent were stories of the encounter that Capt. Verne Rasmussen of the police homicide squad said he intended to question some of the notables. The guest list included, among others, Mickey Rooney, Dinah Shore, Charles Chaplin, Tyrone Power and Annabella, Alexander Korda and Merle Oberon.

"We may have a homicide case on our hands," Rasmussen commented, as police stepped into the inquiry four days after the fight.

Booked on suspicion of assault with intent to do bodily harm was James Fleming, 33, Flynn's former butler and now also his personal secretary. Fleming, six feet two inches tall but weighing only 155 pounds, described himself as "hardly the pugilistic type."

But he admitted, in a statement to detectives for the district attorney's office, that he struck Eric Gosta, the butler, hired to tend bar for the evening, insisting: "I hit him after he took a swing at me."
