The council yesterday also approved the execution of a contract between the city and the county for the joint operation of the new 250-watt police radio transmitter, for which an application for a Federal license to operate is still pending.

Under the terms of the contract, Councilman Edgar L. Yow said. the county will operate two twoway radio cars through the system and pay the city 20 per cent of the cost of the operation of the transmitter for the privilege. The city will also maintain the coun ty's radio units with the county furnishing replacement parts.

The contract was required by the Federal Communications com mission, Councilman Yow said. before the commission would con sider granting a license for the 250-watt frequency modulated transmitter which has been purchased and installed by the city to replace the present inadequate 100-watt police transmitter.

Negotiations are also under way the councilman revealed, to have two-way radios installed in police cars at Carolina and Wrightsville Beaches under a similar arrangement, thus providing a complete police radio network for the coun-


