ST. LOUIS. Sept. 25 .- (AP) -The fighting St. Louis Browns climbed into a first place tie with Detroit tonight in the American league pennant race as they defeated the Boston Red Sox 3 to 0 behind the brilliant two hit pitching of Nelson Potter.

The veteran right hander pitched eight innings of scoreless baseball and his game was marred only by two consecutive scratch bingles in the third inning by Roy Partee and Skeeter Newsome.

The Sox had only one base runner after that third inning, Newsome, who reached first in the eighth on an error by George Mc-

Chet Laabs and Rookie Boris "Babe" Martin were the bright spots in the eight-hit Brownie attack on Clem Driesewerd and Francis Barrett.

Laabs' first inning home run sent Luke Sewell's men off to a lead and he later got a hit and scored the Browns second run in the seventh. Martin doubled his first time up and singled Laabs home in the seventh in his first major league appearance.


