

War Costs Germans 50 Generals On West Line

SUPREME HEADQUARTERS LLIED EXPEDITIONARY FORCE, March 10 .- (AP) -The war has cost the German army 50 generals on the western front alone, 18 of them killed and 32 captured, Allied headquarters dis-

closed today.

In addition, the Wehrmacht has lost three colonels in command of divisions, four admirals and or vice-admiral. Among the generals captured were six full generals, 12 lieutenant-generals and 14 major generals.

The dead include two field marshals, Erwin Rommel and Guenther Von Kluge, the latter a sui cide. Rommel, victim of an Allied air attack in France, was commander of German army group B Von Kluge was commander in chief in the west.

Membership Of UAW Shows Big Decrease

DETROIT, March 10 .- The United Automobile Workers Union CIO), with more than one mil ion members, sustained a mem bership decrease of 113,741 from May through November, George F. Addes, international secretary-

reasurer, said today. Addes attributed the decrease to cutbacks in war production plants

during that period. The secretary-treasurer report ed the UAW's income during the six-month period totaled \$3,248,and expenditures \$3,258,-886.57. He recommended an increase in dues to \$1.50 a month, 85 cents being retained by the locals and 65 cents going to the international. Of the present \$1 a month dues, the local retains 60 cents and sends - 40 cents to the international union.






