SCHOOL OFFICIALS TO ASK ELECTION

New Hanover County Board of Education is understood to have prepared a resolution, to be presented to the County Board of Commissioners at its next regular session, requesting that an election be called in connection with the proposed junior college. The question at the polls would be whether the people are willing to authorize a 5-cent tax to supplement tuition to be paid by pupils, for maintenance of the school. The legislature, in the last week of its session, adopted an enabling act, presented by Rep. J. Q. LeGrand, providing for such an election. The school board's resolution is in line with this legislative provision.
