GIRL SCOUTING CAMP WILL OPEN
The first annual eight-week camping season of the Wilmington Girl Scouts will be inaugurated on June 13 at which time the local scouts will combine with the Goldsboro Girl Scouts to open Camp Trailee at Dudley, Miss. Dorothy Walls, director of local Girl Scout camps, said yesterday.
