

### CHERRY TO DEFER SETTING OF DATE

RALEIGH, Dec. 27—(AP)—Governor Cherry said today he would defer "for the time being" the setting of a date for a special election in the 10th Congressional district to fill the vacancy caused by death of Rep. Joe W. Ervin.

Under state law, the Governor sets the date for a special district election to fill a vacancy which occurs after a candidate has been elected in the regular election and before the next general primary.

Cherry said in the present instance he planned to withhold his announcement of an election until arrangements have been made as to nomination of candidates by the Democratic and Republican parties.

However, Attorney General Harry McMullan said that under state law "there is no provision in the statutes for nomination of a candidate to fill a Con-

gressional vacancy between general elections." In that case, he said, several candidates representing the two major political parties may figure in the balloting.

In recent instance where vacancies have occurred in Congress, the Republican and Democratic parties have agreed on single candidates for the special elections, thus narrowing the field to two. The District Democratic Executive committee usually nominates its party candidate.

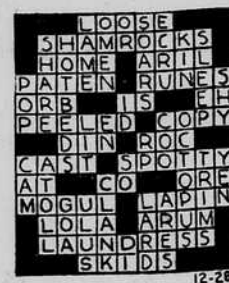
### France Will Approve Moscow Peace Proposal

"If there is nothing in it about the Rhineland or any similar subject of particularly vital interest to us, the cabinet will undoubtedly take favorable action," one source said.
