Representing Wilmington Girl Scout council at the National Convention of the Girl Scout organization in March at Atlantic City, N. J., will be Mrs. J. S. Webb and Mrs. Helen C. Jones; Alternates, Mrs. H. W. Winkle, and Mrs. J. Wallace West.

This meeting will be the first postwar National Convention held and will last three days beginning March 20, Mrs. G. D. Greer, commissioner, announced and it will be attended by accredited delegates from the nation's 1,422 Girl Scout councils.

Guest of honor at the convention and speaker at an international banquet will be Lady Baden-Powell, wife of the late Lord Robert Baden-Powell, founder of the Scouting movement for both boys and girls.

"Girl Scouting-Citizenship in Action Around the World," will be the general theme for other speakers at the convention.

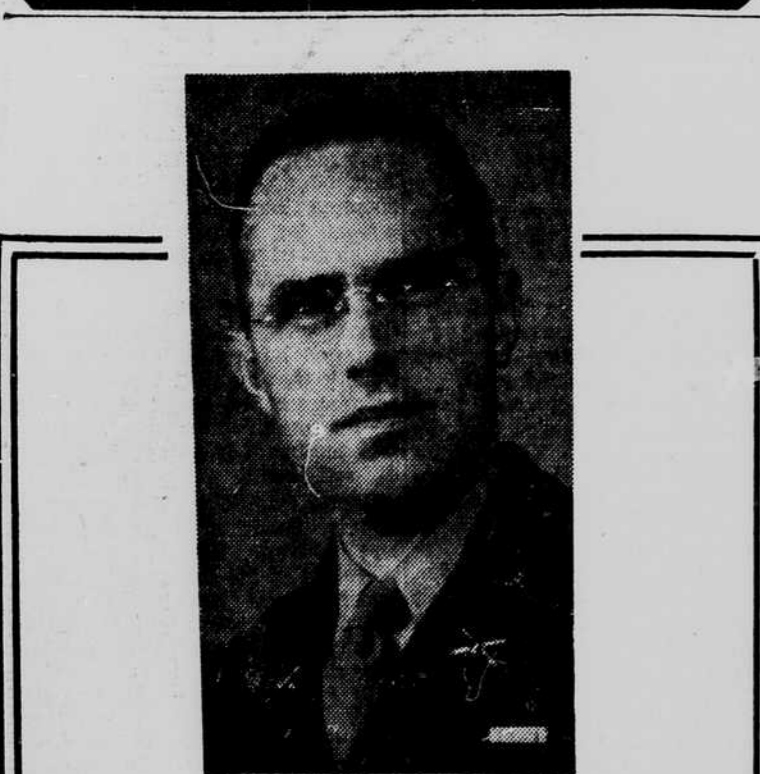

### GALLUP POLL SAYS:

## President Truman 1948 Choice Of Two-Thirds Of Democrats Casting Votes

### Survey Of Party Members Throughout U. S. Shows Wallace Second, Eisenhower In Third Spot; Lead Below FDR's

One of a series of articles analyzing political sentiment today on parties, candidates and issues.

By GEORGE GALLUP Director, American Institute of Public Opinion PRINCETON, N. J., February 7.—Harry S. Truman is the choice of two out of every three Democratic voters for renomination as president in 1948, with Henry A. Wallace at present running next most popular among the rank and file of the party's voters.

The Institute's poll of Democratic voters on the question of presidential preference also found Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower Secretary of State James F. Byrnes, Edward R. Stettinius, Jr., former Secretary of State, Fiorello H. LaGuardia, ex-mayor of New York; James A. Farley, one-time head of the Democratic National Committee, and Sen. Alben W. Barkley among those mentioned prominently.

Mr. Truman's lead in the poll, while substantial, is not as large as the popular lead which Franklin D. Roosevelt had in the years before the 1940 and the 1944 Democratic nominating conventions.

The vote today among the Democratic rank and file stating a preference: "What man would you like to see elected president of the country in 1948?"

A year and a half before the 1944 presidential race, Mr. Roosevelt polled 79 per cent among Democratic voters asked to name their choice for the nomination, with Mr. Wallace running next with 8 per cent, and James A. Farley, third with 5 per cent.

The same one-sidedness prevailed before the 1940 campaign. Mr.

Roosevelt polled 83 per cent as the choice of the rank and file a year in advance of the election, as against 8 per cent for the next most popular, John N. Garner, of Texas.

Although the Democratic party today is not quite so much of a one-man show, Mr. Truman does definitely overshadow the others in vote of preference. As for the Republican party, the picture is considerably less one-sided.

As reported earlier in the week, Governor Dewey, of New York, and Ex-Governor Harold Stassen, of Minnesota, are out in front with 38 per cent and 27 per cent respectively, while John W. Bricker, who was the party's nominee for vice-president in 1944, is third with 8 per cent.

General Eisenhower, who has remained aloof from party politics, appears prominently on both the Republican and Democratic lists.

AMONG OTHER presidential preferences mentioned by Democratic voters in today's poll are: Senator Byrd, of Virginia; Senator William Fulbright, of Arkansas; Secretary of the Treasury Vinson, Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, Governor Frank J. Lausche, of Ohio; Sen. Tom Connally, of Texas; Mayor William O'Dwyer, of New York; Sen. Walter Geore, of Georgia; Philip Murray of the CIO.; Paul V. McNutt, Gen. George C. Marshall, Sumner Welles, Gov. Coke Stevenson, of Texas; Sen. Claude Pepper, of Florida; Supreme Court Justice Robert H. Jackson, and Jesse Jones, former head of the RFC.
