Your GI Rights

Questions and Answers On Servicemen's Problems

By DOUGLAS LARSEN WASHINGTON—Veterans and their relatives have sent in the following questions: Q—My brother just got back from overseas, where he was in several battles...

Q—Is it possible for a veteran to get a government-guaranteed loan for the purchase of a house, and at the same time get money from the government for continuing his education?

Q—My son was in the Marine Corps for close to three years, yet he never had one day of furlough. Can he get any money for the furlough time he should have received?

Q—My son is getting veterans' unemployment compensation. Will this be deducted from any future bonus he might receive from the government?

Q—My husband was 4-F during the war. Last month he was drafted. Will he be eligible for the GI benefits when he gets out?

MARCH CIRCULATION REPORT SHOWS TOTAL OF 13,068 BOOKS

A total of 3,068 books were circulated from the Wilmington Public Library in March, according to a report issued to the city council by Miss Emma Woodard, librarian, yesterday.

The total includes books circulated from the Lake Forest library and the Bookmobile. The breakdown of figures was: Public library—children's books, 555; adult's books, 6,201; Lake Forest library—children's books, 873; adult's books, 1,035; Bookmobile—Riverside apartments, 60; Raleigh building 931; Vance building, 338; Wrightsboro, 387; Hewes building, 119; Washington Catlett, 735; Winter Park, 47; Seagate, 146; Wrightsville sound, 66; Wrightsville Beach, 79; Kure's Beach, 76; and Carolina Beach, 419.
