Confederate Air Force Organized Last March, Now Has Five Branches

 NEW BERN, Oct. 31—The Confederate Air Force, organized here last March by "Col." Mike Holton and "Col." Albert T. McSorley, former Air Corps members, continue to grow and expand. More than 100 members have joined, and three new branches have been formed, to make a total of five

branches for the local headquarters. Previously branches had been organized at Atlanta, Ga., and Frankfurt Germany. More recently new branches have been reported from Marietta, Macon and St. Simon's Island, all in Georgia. The Confederate Air Force engineers here laid out the new Hardison airport at Jasper and participated in its dedication program.
