ROYALL PROTESTS COST DUPLICATION

Undersecretary Of War Praises Work Of All Service Branches

CORNITH, Miss., Nov. 11 — (AP) — Undersecretary of War Kenneth V. Royall praised the heroes of war Monday and then launched into some biting criticism of what he termed money wasted in duplication of services by the military.

Royall addressed the tri-state Armistice Day observance here. He said:

"There is no place in American defense plans for selfish ambition in the naval or in the military air services.

"And yet today we find wasteful duplications that cannot be justified. There can, for example, be no excuse for having both an Army and at a nearby Navy airfield two headquarters and two complete flight services. It may be an interesting game to find out whether the weather is the same at two locations half a mile apart, but it is an expensive game.

"It is hard to see why the Army and Navy must have two complete and separate communications systems.

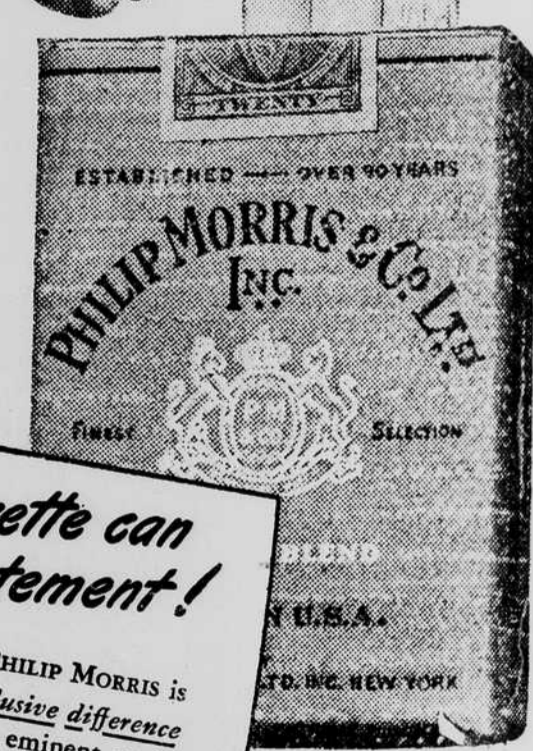
