SISTERHOOD PLANS SPECIAL PROGRAM

Temple Israel To Be Scene Of Memorial Exercises Tonight

A special service, conducted in its entirety by members of the temple sisterhood of Temple Israel, will be held tonight honoring the memory of Dr. Isaac M. Wise, founder of reform Judaism in America, Rabbi Pizer Jacobs announced last night.

Rabbi Jacobs said the service is known as "Sisterhood Sabbath," and occurs once a year in the temple, and takes place in the month of March—the month of Dr. Wise's birthday anniversary.

Dr. Wise was born in Bohemia in 1819 and came to America at the age of 27, to establish progressive Judaism in the United States.

He first organized the Union of American Hebrew congregations in 1873, Dr. Jacobs said, while he was rabbi in Cincinnati, at which time reform or progressive Judaism had its origin. Since that time it has grown to be a most representative branch of Judaism in America, Dr. Jacobs added.

In 1875, Dr. Jacobs said, Dr. Wise founded the Hebrew Union College of Cincinnati for the ordination of reformed rabbis and in 1889 he founded the Central Conference of American Rabbis.

The opening prayer tonight will be by Mrs. L. L. Lucas, president of the Concordia Sisterhood; the prayers will be read by Mrs. Alfred Sternberger and Mrs. S. E. Warshauer.

The address of the occasion will be delivered by Mrs. Herbert Blumenthal and Mrs. Harris Newman.

Rabbi Jacobs said there also would be services Saturday morning at 11 o'clock, conducted by the rabbi.

CENSUS BUREAU PUTS 8,513,489 FIGURE ON 1946 GINNING

WASHINGTON, March 20—(P)—The census bureau reported today that cotton ginned from the 1946 crop totaled 8,513,489 running bales.

This compared with 8,813,453 ginned from the 1945 crop and 11,839,366 from the 1944 crop.

Included in the total for the 1946 were 29,356 bales which growers estimated would be turned out after the bureau's March canvass.

Included also were 2,386 bales of American-Egyptian cotton compared with 4,054 for 1945, and 13 of Sea Island cotton compared with 14 for 1945.

Ginnings by states for 1946 and 1945, respectively, included: North Carolina 443,705 and 431,327; South Carolina 689,681 and 655,202.
