

### TRACTOR TO BE SHOWN TODAY

#### Farmall Cub Will Be Demonstrated On Swart Farm This Afternoon

A special demonstration of International Harvester Company's new, small, low-cost Farmall Cub tractor is scheduled to be held from 2 until 5 p. m. today on the D. Swart Farm at Castle Haynes, nine miles north of Wilmington on Highway 117. It was announced yesterday.

The demonstration, open to the public, is sponsored by the Marks Machinery Company of Wilmington.

ton. Everyone is invited to "get the feel" of the Cub, which will make modern farm tractor power available to approximately 3,000,000 farms having small acreage.

"Designed specifically for use by small general farms, industrial workers who divide their time between industry and the farm, truck farm operators, orchardists and large general farms needing auxiliary units, the Farmall Cub is being introduced into the Farmall tractor line in response to the desire of the small acreage farmer to compete on a comparable basis with farmers of larger tracts," is the way it is described.

It will plow to three and a half acres per 10 hours; cultivate one to four rows of crops at a rate of better than one acre per hour with a four-cylinder, four-cycle engine which used less than a gallon of fuel an hour, it was reported.

It weighs 1,200 pounds and has about 9 and one-quarter horsepower on the belt and eight on the drawbar and will cost substantially below the Farmall A tractor.

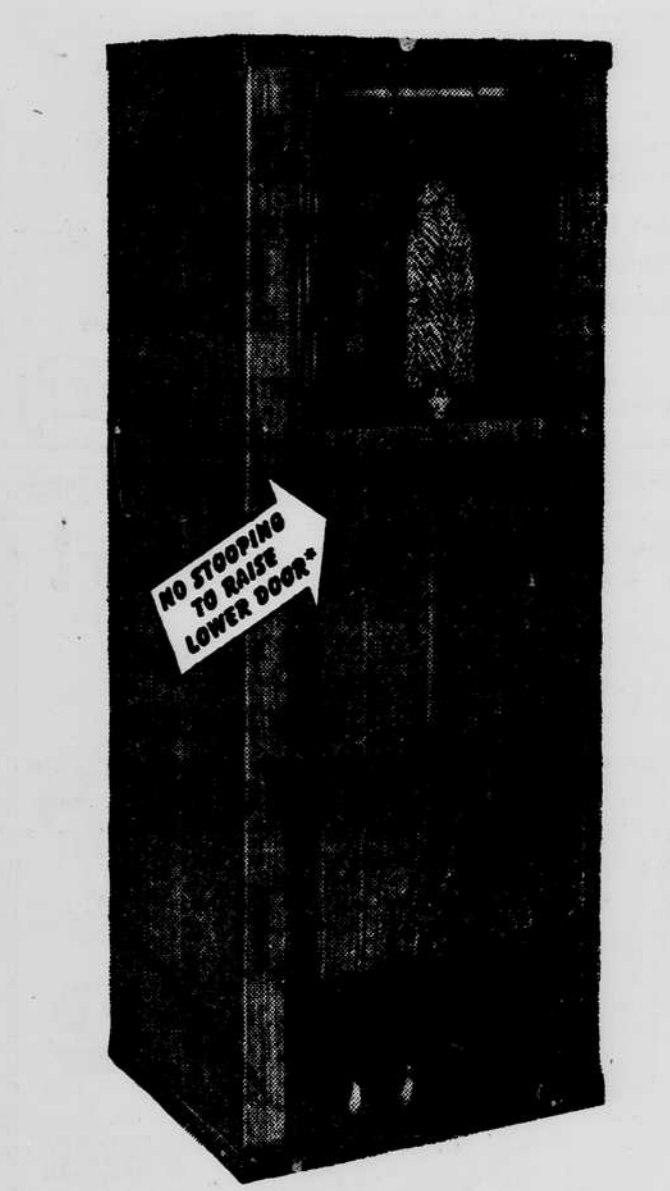
