NEGRO WINS WINGS AT LOCAL AIRPORT

Herman L. Anderson, Negro, of 114 South 10th street, won his wings at Blueheath airport yesterday when he soloed as a student of the Atlantic School of Aviation in training under the GI Bill of rights.

The Atlantic school, operating at Blueheath since July 1, is a new corporation which gives aviation instruction to Negro veterans exclusively under the GI Bill, although white students are privately enrolled.

Anderson is one of 10 Negro veterans who are currently in training. His instructor is Edward Gibbs, Negro, who came to Wilmington from New York City and is making his home here.

Anderson made his first solo flight in an Aeronca champion. The school also uses a Cub cruiser for training flights.

Operators of the Atlantic school are John A. Rehder, president, Burke Reeder, vice president, and J. D. McMeekin, secretary and treasurer.

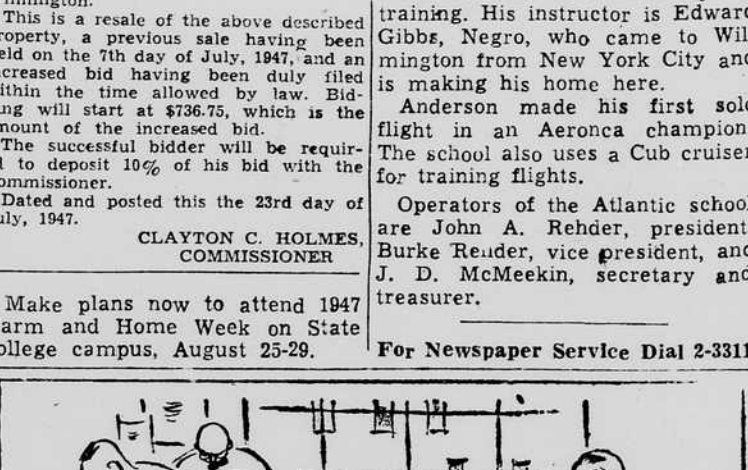

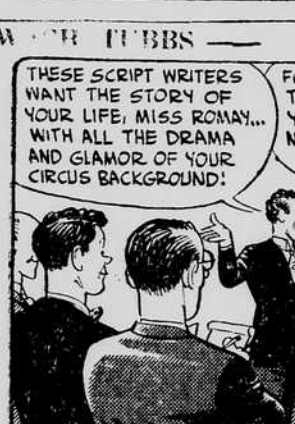

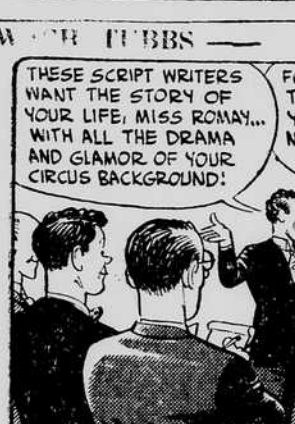
