

4-H HEALTH CLUB WINNERS CROWNED

Gene Dull and Daphion Galloway Crowned King And Queen

RALEIGH, Aug. 21 (AP)—Dr. Carl V. Reynolds, state health officer, tonight crowned the State 4-H Club King and Queen of Health after telling a club audience here that health was a primary objective not only for the club but for all.

The king is Gene Dull, 16-year-old member of the Farmington Senior club in Davie county, and the son of Mr. and Mrs. L. M. Dull of Cana, route one.

The queen is Daphion Galloway, 15-year-old member of the Troy club in Montgomery county, and the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. C. Galloway.

Dr. Reynolds praised the king and queen for winning honors "not through heritage, political policies, popularity or subterfuge, but by a progressive elimination contest."

"To be mentally, morally, and physically fit, we must be basically healthy," Dr. Reynolds advised. "We no longer live in the age of the survival of the fittest."

"A sound mind in a sound body is not an idealist's dream—it is obtainable, and our people should adhere to the axiom that self-preservation is in reality the first law of nature."

He urged his listeners to stimulate interest in their various communities sufficient to bring to the people in the rural areas much needed measures for restoration and maintenance of health.

Earlier today, the 4-H club girls held a dress revue at which Sophia Perry, 17-year-old Bertie county club member, won first prize. She modeled a blue suit which she had converted from her sailor brother's uniform. She will be given a free trip to the National 4-H Club Congress in Chicago in November.

She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. G. H. Perry of Colerain. Joyce Bell Williams, member of the Belle club in Chatham county, won first honors in the high school dress division of the revue, while Hazel Dickerson of the Zeb Vance club in Vance county won formal dress honors.

Miss Williams is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. T. E. Williams. Miss Dickerson, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. W. S. Dickerson. There were 83 girls participating. All made their own dresses and modeled them in the revue.
