BODY OF FARMER MANGLED BY AUTO

John H. McFayden Carver's Creek Killed By Hit-Run Driver

ELIZABETHTOWN, Oct. 7. — The mangled body of John Hines McFayden, well-known Carver's Creek township farmer, was found lying by the Wilmington highway near Carver's Creek at around 6 o'clock this morning and police began a search for a hit-and-run driver. McFayden reportedly had left his home about 4:30 o'clock to take an early bus to Wilmington and had walked to the highway before being hit by a motorist who did not stop. Investigating officers said that his body was mangled beyond recognition, but identification was made from papers found in his pocket.
