

# 38 NABBED IN CHARLOTTE "NUMBERS" RING

58 Negroes, men and women, were nabbed by city, county and SBI raiders in Charlotte last week, when the officers swooped down on the lucrative "numbers" racket. They also picked up some of the heads of the so-called dynasty, white, and released all on bond, for hearing set for September 10 in City Recorder's court.

Well-organized squads went out on schedule after eleven o'clock, on the night of the raids, and from then until day-break the next morning (Thursday), the jail was a steady stream of incoming prisoners. The bond for most was set at \$500 each. The white chiefs were bailed out for \$5,000 each.

For four days the business was quiet, but on Monday morning of this week, the wheels began turning again, and the weekly "take" started heading back to the pockets of the syndicate. The prior investigation was done by SBI Agent

### SANDWICH TRAY

- Liver pate sandwiches
- Peanut butter and onion carrot
- Sea Food sandwich
- Rollab roses, celery curls, rice pilaf

### Liver Pate Sandwiches

- 1 cup liver pate
- 1 cup finely chopped celery
- 2 tsp. onion juice
- 1 tsp. celery salt
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/2 tsp. mayonnaise
- Mix pate and celery well
- Press pate, then add mayonnaise and seasonings and blend well
- Serve on rye or brown bread

### Chicken Salad Sandwiches

- 1/2 cup minced chicken
- 1/2 cup minced green pepper
- 1/2 cup minced onion
- 1/2 cup salad dressing
- Mix minced chicken with chopped egg and remaining ingredients
- Sprinkle with softened butter or mayonnaise. Wonderful on enriched white bread

### Cucumber and Cheese Filling

- 1/2 cup cream cheese
- 1/2 cup salt
- 1/2 cup lemon juice
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup cucumber, remove seeds, cut into small strips and soak for 3 hours in salt water (1/2 tsp salt to 1 cup water). Drain and dry cucumber on towel, add cheese, salt, lemon juice, mixing well.
- White bread by all means

### Sea Food Sandwich Filling

- 1/2 cup lobster (or snail) chopped
- 1/2 cup finely chopped celery
- 1/2 cup chard stuffed shrimps
- 1/2 cup salt
- Mix ingredients and add solid dressing to moisten.
- White or brown bread as preferred.

Note: All these fillings can be prepared well in advance and stored in the refrigerator. These same fillings are also delicious spread on potato chips and served as canapés.

# WHITE HOUSE REPORTER SUES FOR 10 GRANDS

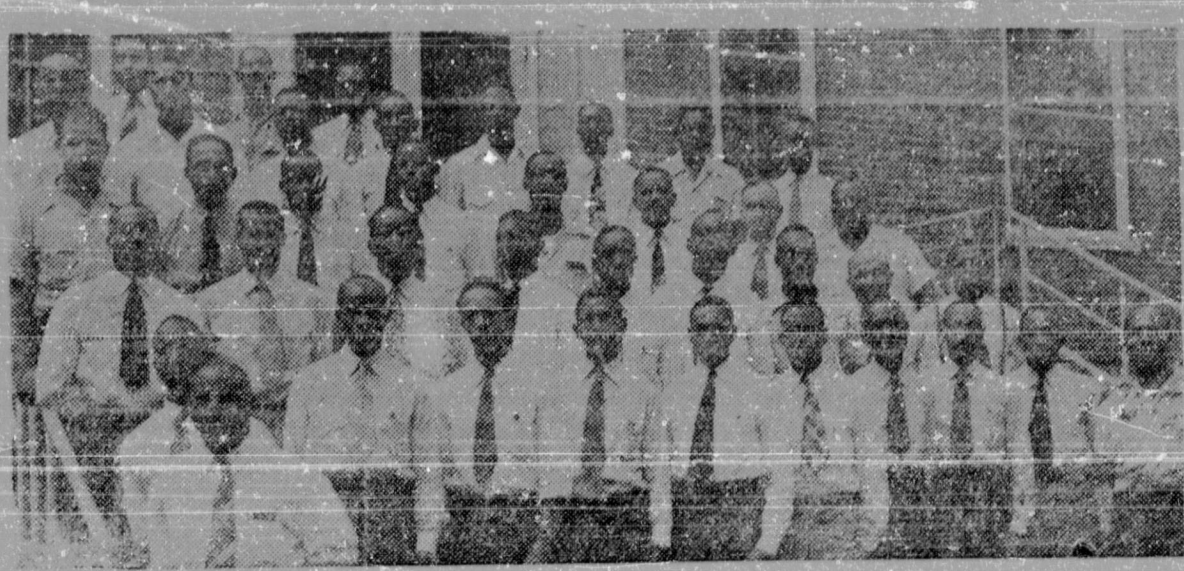

Lautier, Negro White House correspondent, filed a \$10,000 damage suit against Harry McAlpin and Alfred Smith, alias "Charley Cherchez-le-Main," in District court here August 21.

The suit states that Manuscript in the issue of July 9 said "an article of the White House called Negro papers and correspondents last week to tell that he had intrusted the White House release on the real FEPC report to Louis Lautier. He (the article) asked Lautier, who promised to deliver, but instead, Lautier wrote a supposedly exclusive story."

Mr. Lautier alleges in his suit against the co-authors "that the statement and charges that he misused a trust by withholding from fellow-newspapermen information that had promised to disseminate among them and used it for his own personal profit and gain, implied that he was untrustworthy, a cheat and a liar."
