FISK PROFESSOR NAMED TO FOREIGN SERVICE

WASHINGTON, D. C. (INPA)—President Truman has approved the appointment by the State Department of Giles A. Hubert, professor of economics at Fisk University, to be a foreign service officer, grade 4. Hubert will be assigned to the United States Embassy at Port-au-Prince, Haiti, where he will serve as agricultural attaché, assuming his new duties about February 1. Training as an agricultural economist, Professor Hubert has been a member of the faculty at Fisk since 1934. During this period he also served for five years as senior agricultural economist in the Farm Security Administration, and for one year as project analyst for the old Resettlement Administration, while

on leave from the university. A graduate of Jackson College and the University of Iowa, he has done advanced study at the University of Minnesota and at the Royal Veterinary and Agricultural College of Copenhagen, Denmark. While at Fisk, Professor Hubert also served as one of the experts who gathered the material on farm tenure problems in the South, which was utilized by the President's Committee on Farm Tenancy in 1935 and which documented the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenacy Act. He has travelled widely in Europe, the Soviet Union and more recently in Caribbean countries.

FLA. WHITES GET SENTENCED FOR RAPE

MIMS, Florida — Bill Hagin and W. L. McKnight have been convicted in Circuit Court and sentenced to prison terms of five and seven years, respectively, on charges of criminal attacks on two Negro high school girls near Chipley, Florida, through the efforts of the Washington County branch of the N. A. A. C. P.

Despite the lightness of the sentences in view of the crimes committed, the convictions established a precedent in that all white juries have persistently refused hitherto to convict white men charged with rape on colored women even in the face of overwhelming evidence of their guilt.

Efforts will now be made to prosecute two embezzlers of Hagin and McKnight who sat in an automobile and watched while the attacks were being perpetrated.

Attorney W. W. Flournoy, a cou-

ageous white lawyer of De Funiak Springs, was retained by the Washington County Branch of the N. A. A. C. P. to assist in the prosecution.
