They are the prime requisites upon which your automobile will be judged (although there are 24 major factors which your car or truck must pass in order to be given an "APPROVED" Sticker). Study the points enumerated at the left, and, prior to compulsory state inspection—

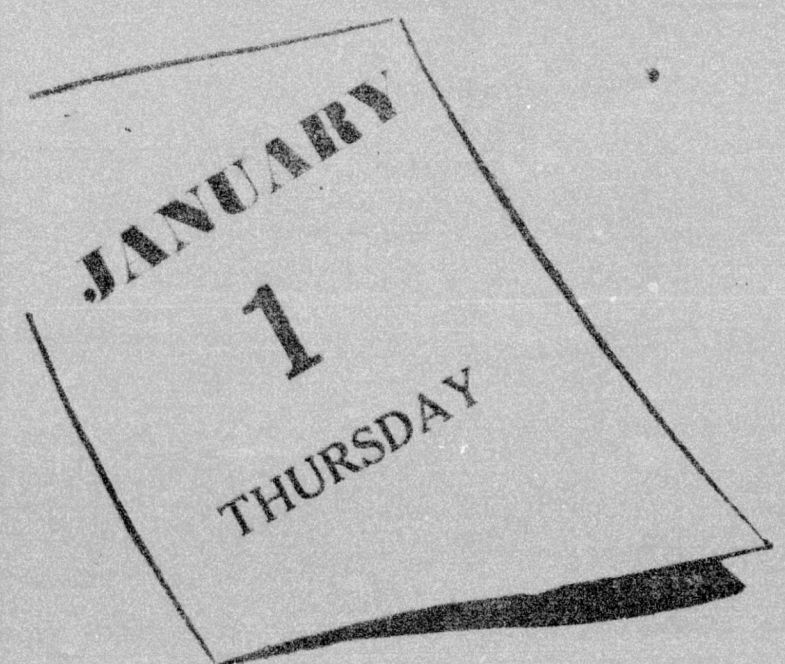
### Put Your Car In Readiness N-O-W!

During 1948 each vehicle must be inspected only once, but it will be unwise to wait until the end of the year to visit the Inspection Station. You are urged to go early and avoid the rush. The inspection of each vehicle will take only a short time (about five to ten minutes). It will not be necessary that the car owner appear at the Inspection Station. (The vehicle may be driven by any licensed operator.)

Inspection Station as soon as it opens...*

You will be given an "INSPECTION CARD" and your car checked throughout the lane for any deficiencies on the 25 MAJOR POINTS listed on the card. Any mechanical defects will be noted on this card and you will be required to have them corrected in a limited time. This inspection card becomes your personal property and will be used later to aid repair shops in correcting the defects. If a vehicle is rejected, it is up to the owner to get the defects corrected. When this has been done, the car may be returned to the Inspection Station for another test, and if found to be in good order, an "APPROVED" sticker will be issued.
