CITY BUS ROUTE CHANGES. Beginning Thursday morning, January 29th the changes in city bus routings outlined below will become effective. FOREST HILLS ROUTE, ST. MARY'S ROUTE, GLENWOOD AVENUE ROUTE, OBERLIN-MARTIN STREET, NEW BERN AVENUE ROUTE, BUDLEIGH ROUTE, OTHER ROUTES.

FOREST HILLS ROUTE

All buses on this route will proceed out Hillsboro Street as usual to Brooks Avenue, thence along Brooks Avenue to Barmettler Street where it will turn left and proceed to Dixie Trail...

ST. MARY'S ROUTE

Beginning at the intersection of Fayetteville and Hargett Streets and running thence along Hargett Street to Wilmington Street, thence along Wilmington Street to Edenton Street, thence along Edenton Street to Salisbury Street, thence along Salisbury Street to Hillsboro Street, thence along Hillsboro Street to St. Mary's Street, thence along St. Mary's Street to Fayetteville Street.

GLENWOOD AVENUE ROUTE

All buses on this route will proceed out Glenwood Avenue to St. Mary's Street as usual. From this point every other bus will continue east St. Mary's Street to White Oak Road and from there return along the same route to the loading zone on Hargett Street.

OBERLIN-MARTIN STREET, NEW BERN AVENUE ROUTE

Beginning at the intersection of Oberlin Road and Colonial Road and running thence along Oberlin Road to Fairview Road, thence along Fairview Road to St. Mary's Street, thence along St. Mary's Street to Colonial Road, thence along Colonial Road to Oberlin Road, thence along Oberlin Road to Hillsboro Street, thence along Hillsboro Street to Gardner Street, thence along Gardner Street to Mayview Road, thence along Mayview Road to Canterbury Road, thence along Canterbury Road to Fairview Road, thence along Fairview Road to the intersection of Glen Avenue.

OTHER ROUTES... All routes not mentioned above will continue to follow the same course and operate on schedules now in effect.
