SCHOOL STORY

Although the Citizens Committee-PTA delegation is expected to prepare a report on all of the Negro community's complaints concerning the school system, the Ministerial Alliance has confined itself to the issue of the location of the Negro high school.

EXPRESSES GRATIFICATION

The Rev. M. W. Williams, chairman of the Citizens Committee and a member of the Ministerial Alliance, expressed gratification at the progress made by the ministerial group but said that formal recommendations from his group would await conclusion of pending conferences and a mass meeting at which the findings and conclusions would be reported.

PREAMBLE

RESOLUTION

Whereas the Board of Education of Raleigh has proposed a program of improvement of the public school system; and Whereas, it is proposed that a new elementary school building and gymnasium be constructed on the present site of the Washington High School; and Whereas, it has been proposed that the present Washington High School building be remodeled and continued in use as a Junior and Senior High School; and Whereas, the judgment of the Ministerial Alliance is that the present site of the Washington High and Elementary School is entirely unsuitable for the following reasons:

- 1. The present site is located in a depressed residential and business area with unwholesome influences in the lives of the boys and girls who attend school there.
2. The present site is located on the southern fringe of the city directly opposite to the trend of growth of the Negro population.
3. Health and safety hazards are encountered by the hundreds of school children being required to traverse the present site.
4. Inadequate transportation facilities and remoteness of the present school site make it so inaccessible that the institution does no and cannot serve as a constructive social agency in the community.
5. A large majority of the Negro citizens of Raleigh are and have been unalterably opposed to the present location of the Washington High School for the reasons mentioned above.

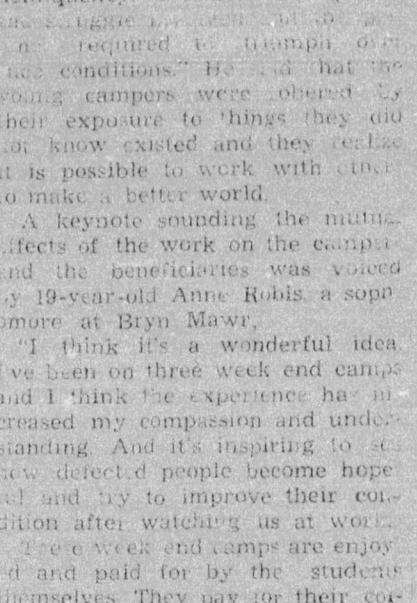
DIXIE LIBERALS

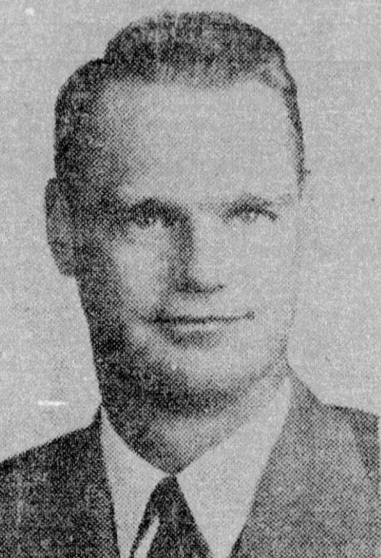
VERSIONS OF CRASH DIFFER

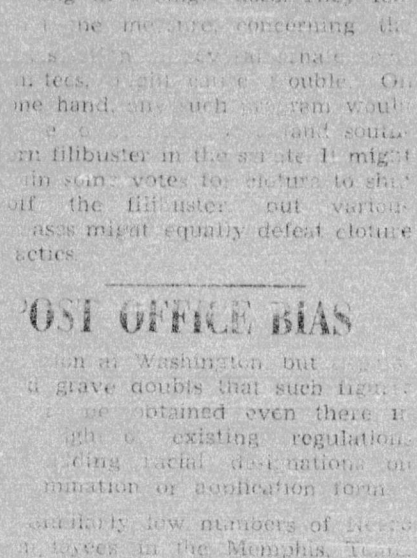

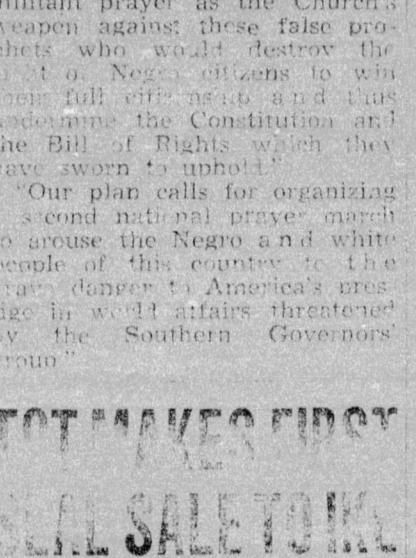

NLRB Is Urged To Refuse To Authorize J. C. Union

WASHINGTON-In an effort to assure Negro steelworkers the National Tube Company equal opportunities to promote the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People has urged the National Labor Relations Board to deny the petition of the Bricklayers, Masons and Plasterers Union of America to represent a small group of white workers in a separate union of bricklayers and apprentices.

The attention of the NLRB was called to the fact that United States Supreme Court decisions have established that no union acting under the federal statute may lawfully engage in discrimination. The NAACP stated that the record shows conclusively that the group applying to the Board bargaining agent has been instrumental in discriminating against Negro workers and effecting a work stoppage when three Negro helpers were promoted to the position of bricklayers' apprentice.

Nurses Offer To Quit As New Graduate Is Put In Post Of Superintendent
