The Rev. J. D. McRae preached one of the most inspiring sermons from the first Epistles of John. His text came from the first chapter, fifth verse: "And this is the Message which we have heard from him and announce unto you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him and walk in the darkness, we lie and do not the truth; but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another; and the blood of Jesus his son cleanseth us from all sin."

What God is and the things of which he consists, The Rev. Mr. McRae explained to the congregation that God is somebody and his consists of a number of things. He explained that what God is or what God was, is what he is, and what he is, is what he will be. This view out of the Sunday School lesson "God is and forever will be." There isn't anything about him that manifests or shows signs of darkness upon us both day and night. We would not be able to see these things.

The Rev. Mr. McRae further explained, so far as we are concerned that knowledge of all darkness disposed of becomes a symbol of truth. Knowledge and truth corporated as partners is almost indispensable. In the divine conception of truth there is no mistake, no error, nothing but right and righteousness. He is a God of life which finds him a symbol of holiness. Darkness symbolizes sin. God doesn't do any wrong, everything around him is light. The Christian and the righteous man has been called from darkness to light.

It is true that God is the author of life and only through the spiritual sense is it taken in this text.
