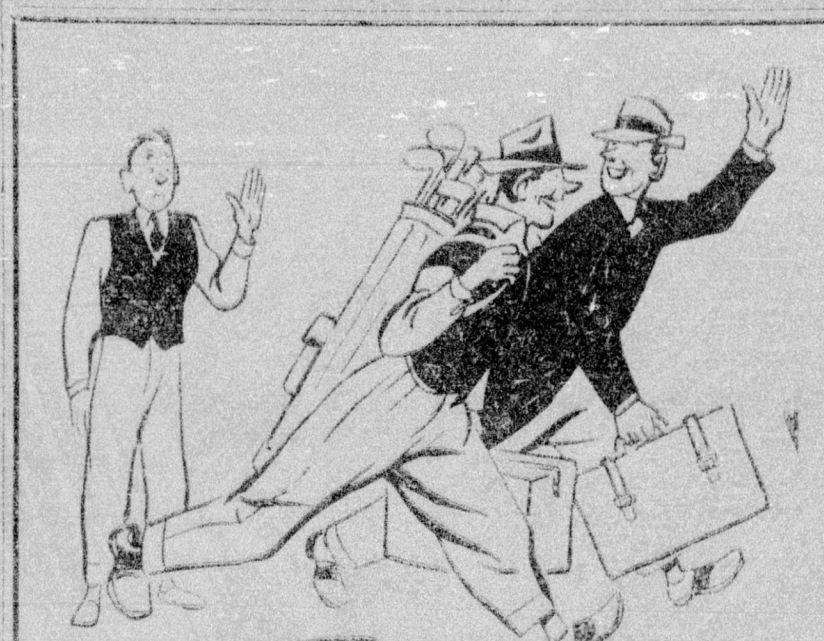
PLEA FOR RACIAL

he had often warned that the governors of southern states might conduct a joint survey to determine and for all what aspirations of the Negro would endanger racial peace and what aspirations would threaten to bring about a complete overthrow of miscegenation.

Declaring that he was "disturbed" by the declaration of Federal District Judge J. Walter Waring of South Carolina that the colored man would never be voting in that state if it were not for the compulsion exercised by the law, he said that such an attitude and expression provided ammunition for the radicals among Negroes who would seek their gains by force.

PROPOSE ERECTION

Summing up the League's position, its president stated: "All intelligent people, white and colored, are becoming greatly concerned about the general welfare of the masses of colored people in the South, for they realize that the moral, social and economic condition of the colored people will have much to do with the progress of the South."
