



Pension Boost Hits Snag In S. C.

COLUMBIA, S. C. (AP)—A proposed measure for a \$33 monthly old age pension hit a snag in the legislature here last week when the house military and naval affairs committee turned it in a majority unfavorable report. The measure, introduced by Rep. Easton, president of the Southern Old Age pension association, Spartanburg, called for levying approximately \$12,000,000 a year in new and additional taxes to make up the difference between present \$22 a month pen-

BENNETT SLATES INSTITUTE FOR NC HOMEMAKERS

Through the measure, half of the people benefiting by the program in South Carolina would be Negroes, since the population is about 50-50 black and white. Its \$22 pension by pensioning the federal government pays 15.




