#### PARENTS SUE IN TRY TO OBTAIN EQUAL SCHOOLS

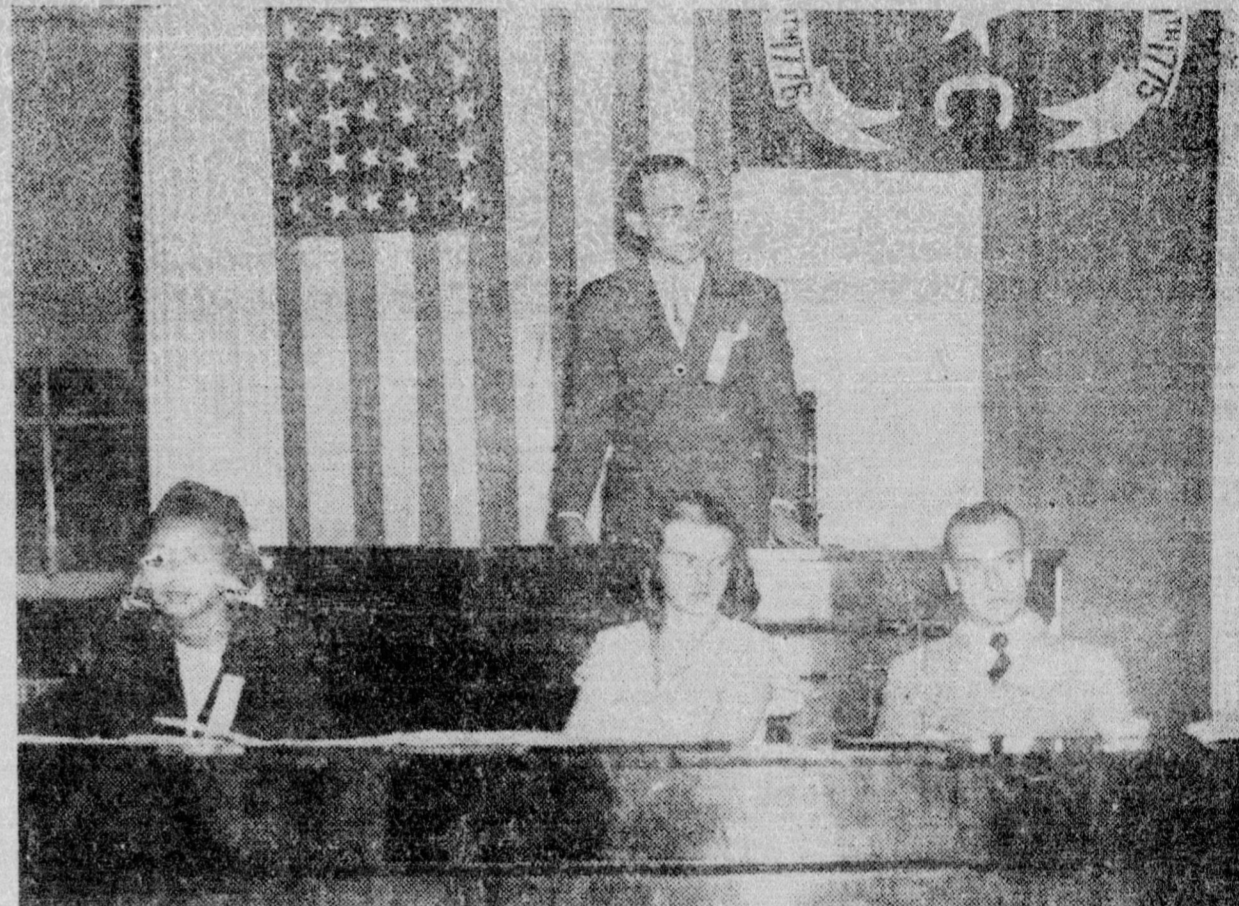

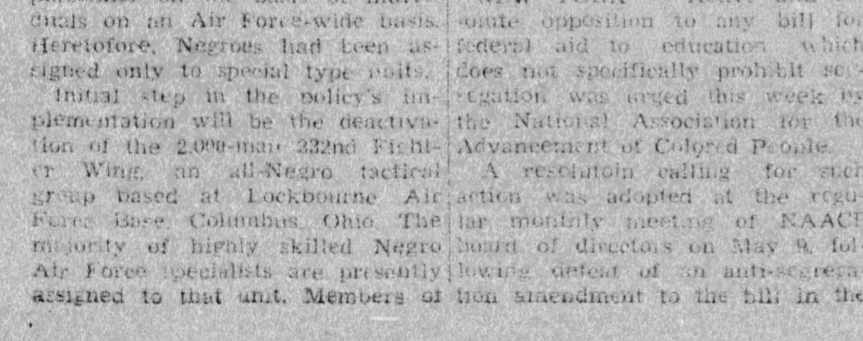

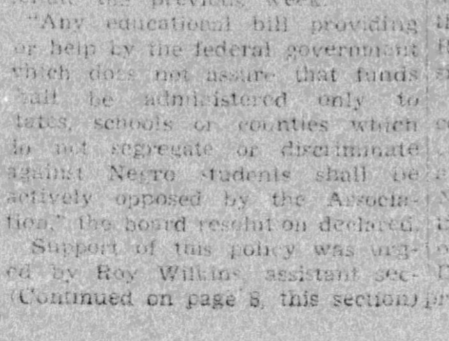
