SHAW TO BEGIN 84TH ACADEMIC YEAR TUESDAY

Preparations are being made at Shaw University for the beginning of the institution's 84th academic year. Members of the teaching faculty and the staffs of the university's many areas of service will begin returning this weekend. President Robert P. Daniel has announced a meeting of the staff for Tuesday morning, September 13, at 10:30 o'clock. The annual Faculty Conference will be held Wednesday morning. Afternoon sessions will be held on both days.

Freshman students will arrive on the campus the following day. Three hundred new students are expected. Orientation activities will begin Friday and will continue through Tuesday, September 26. The new students will be given a psychological examination and a test in English. They will also hear talks by University officials designed to aid them in their adjustment to the school program. Several entertainment-features also are planned.

Registration of freshmen and upper classmen will be completed during the first part of the week. (Con'd on back page, this section)
