SHAW TO BEGIN 84TH ACADEMIC YEAR TUESDAY

Prepartions are being made at Shaw University for the beginning of the institution's 84th academic year. Members of the teaching faculty and the staffs of the university's many areas of service will begin returning this weekend. President Robert P. Daniel has announced a meeting of the staff for Tuesday morning, September 13, at 10:30 o'clock. The annual Faculty Conference will be held Wednesday morning. Afternoon sessions will be held on both days.

Freshmen students will arrive on the campus the following day. Three hundred new students are expected Orientation activities will begin Priday and will continue through Tuesday, September 26. The new students will be given a psychological examination and a test in English. They will also bear talks by University officials designed to aid them in their adjustment to the school program.
