Let's go back to boxing history. At the age of 35, Bob Fitzsimmons, a 147-pounder, won the World Heavyweight boxing championship with such men as James James, Jeffries, Tom Sharkey, James J. Corbett, Gus Ruhlin and Joe Choynick around.

If Joe Louis is too old to fight, it is the reason in his case might add up to his many of his "punches" which is his own business.

When I was a youth, there were 25-year-old boxers around who, to 15 or 25-year-old boxers could hit in a million years. I'll name a few you might have read about.

Jack Johnson, one of the best ever, who boxed for 27 years; Sam Langford, terror of terrars, who was in the squared circle about the Championship of America with Joe Louis and Johnson and who won eight in only one year and that in a considerably blurred eye.

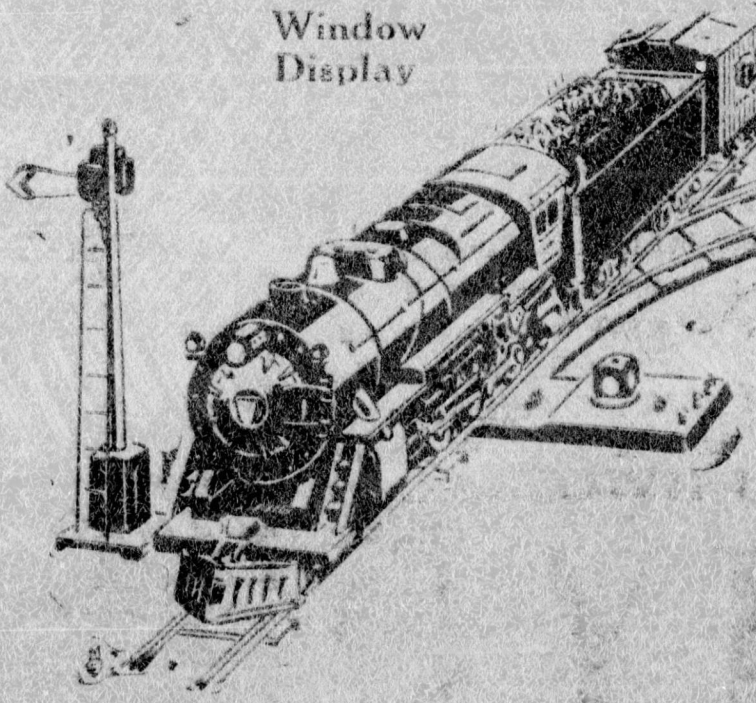

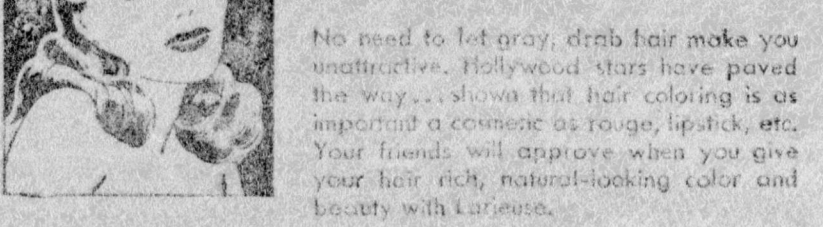
