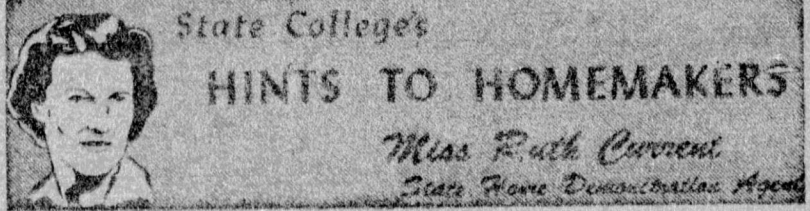

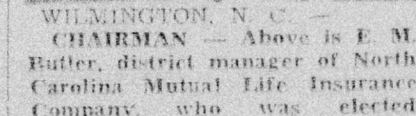

WATT'S NEW By Rosa Lee Armstrong

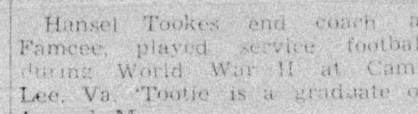
One of the wonderful features of the automatic washing machine is the washing of blankets—easy to do, they come out soft, sweet and clean, ready to be packed away for next year's use. To wash first measure the blanket to determine the size before washing. If the blanket is marked use a small brush dipping in sudsy water, gently rubbing the soiled spots. Use lukewarm water and do not let the washing cycle go for more than two minutes. There are some theories that the agitation causes the shrinkage and not the temperature of the water. The U. S. D. A. recommends a 15 to 20 minute soak period, rather than any washing action. If your machine drains the water out through the bottom of the tub, it might be a good idea to lift the blanket gently out of the agitation or soak period before the draining begins so the dirty water will not be drained through the blanket. If it is spun out, it is done so quickly that the dirty water does not have a chance to go through the blanket. If you are using a non-automatic washer, adjust your wringer loosely. If it drains through the top, no special treatment is necessary. You rinsing temperature should also be mild with two rinses and if dried on the line do it in the shade, preferably on two lines. There will be lint from the blanket and a good stiff brush will remove this. Be sure to check the washer drain for lint before washing again. Check blanked measurement from time to time during drying process and gently pull back into shape. Remember to handle your blankets gently and use a mild synthetic detergent or mild soap suds.

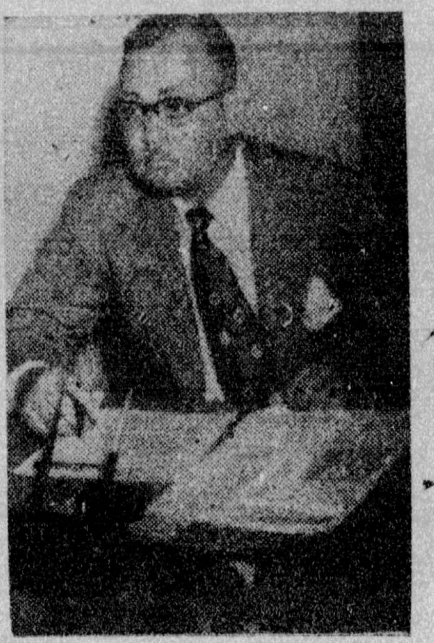

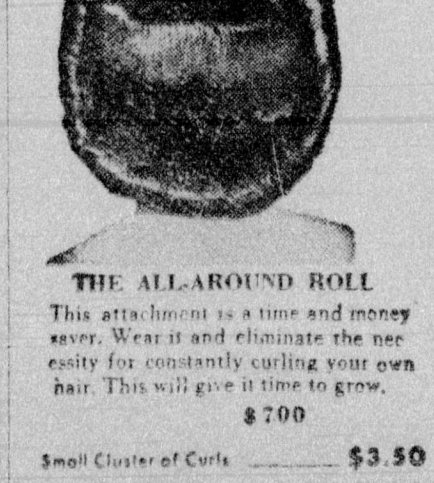
