The large white vote given Dr. Eaten is illustrated by the votes he got in all-white wards. For example, in Carolina Beach, where no Negroes live, he got 85. Winter Park, all-white, gave him 159; Seagate, 170; the candidate got over 400 votes in the nearly all white eighth ward. And,
