

RAGE LACKS FACILITIES

WILMINGTON - Wilmington's Negro citizens who make up about one-third of the total population of the city are weltering through the near-106-degree weather here with no place to so in bathing.

The race's lone bathing spot in municipally - owned Greenfield Loke was taken, and no substiappears in immediate prospect. City Manager J. R. Benson told a group of Negro citizens some lime ago that the city had yet to find a 'suitable bathing spot.' (White citizens both on the front of the lake on the Third Street side.)

However, Benson stressed the idea that Negro citizens were welcome and invited to use the kiddy train, visit the zoo; and stroll receive all such complaints and through the park. When this writreminded him that Negroes had en insulted on occasions when they sought to enjoy the city's park, he quickly replied that this was not the policy of the city sovernment and that he would handle them with dispatch.








